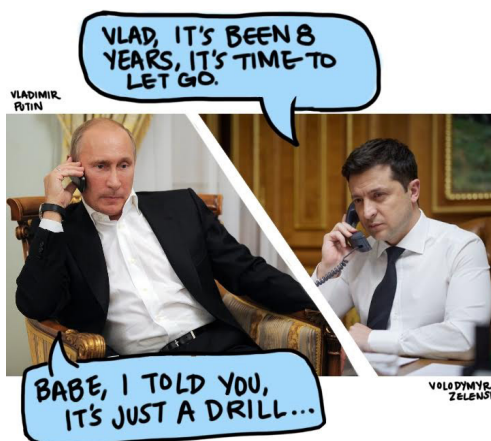

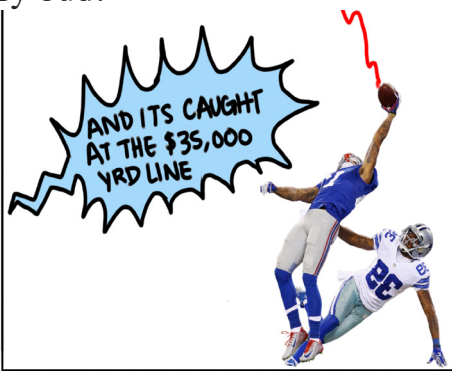
## WINS AND LOSSES
