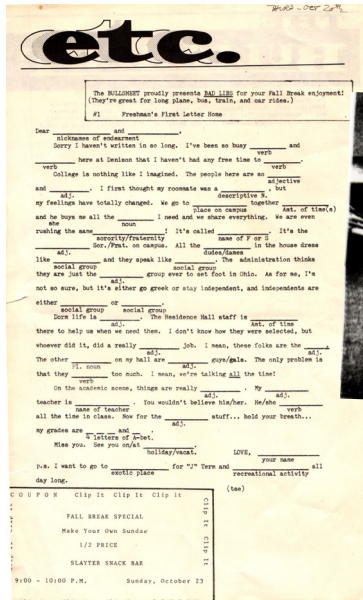
Anyway— thoughts??? I think it's brilliant and I might just be the greatest mind of our generation.

Ghosts of Bullsheet past palling around, drinking the nectar of the Gods (Natty Light)

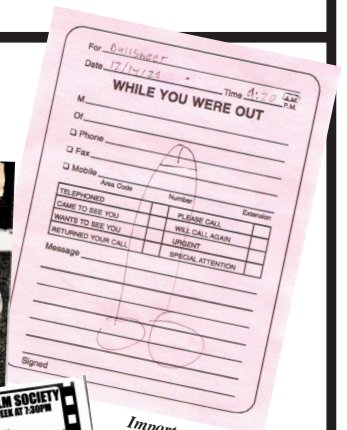

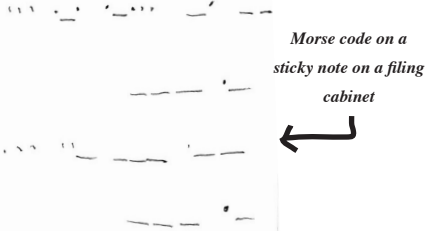

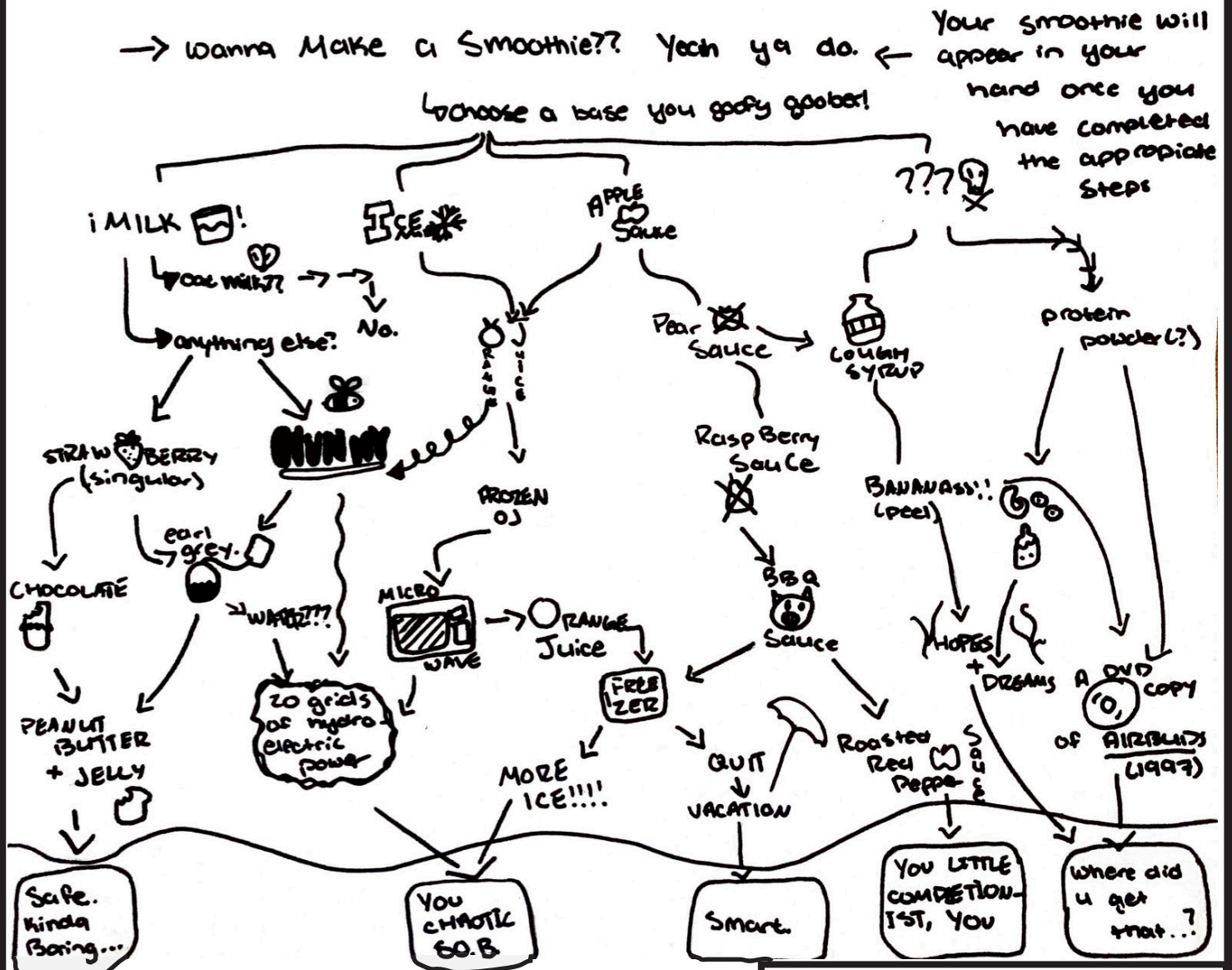
