Interviewer: What's your favorite fruit?

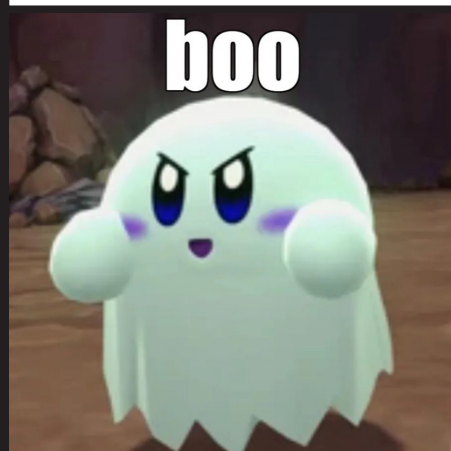
Ghost: I don't know. Cherries are pretty tight.
