Favorite Song: Simples Things

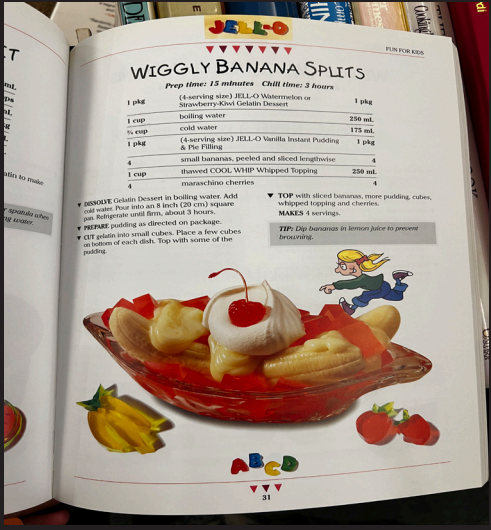
“It started when we were younger, you were mine.... MY BOOOOOO!!”
