# INCREASING STUDENT RETENTION: A BOLD NEW STRATEGY

As you may know, student retention at Denison University is a growing concern of the administration. For a variety of reasons, many students who start their undergraduate education at Denison choose to transfer and finish it elsewhere. Bullsheet reporters spoke to Rev. Shaw Moore, Senior Junior Vice Co-Director of Student Life about what the school is doing to keep students around.

“I’m sure you’ve noticed all of the recent efforts by the school to antagonize its student population,” says Moore. “From the incredibly unpopular First Year Quad, to shutting down the Homestead, our new strategy is both simple and groundbreaking. We want students to stay at Denison University purely out of spite.”

Citing both the sunk cost fallacy and the high rates of Academic Masochism Disorder (AMD) in the student population, Moore believes that increasing anger, stress, and boredom in students is guaranteed to make them stick around.

“[Giving students what they want] has been our big mistake in the past when we’ve tried to bring retention rates up. Students don’t stay because they like a place. Students stay because they imagine themselves after graduation being able to brag about having survived the Denison gauntlet. It’s like bragging about not getting enough sleep. There’s a perverse sociopsychological benefit to doing needlessly hard things.”

Administration is going all in with this new approach. Many popular clubs that have historically given students, particularly marginalized students, a sense of belonging are being cracked down on, such as the BSU, SJP, Outlook, and many others. This “comply in advance” approach to Trump’s DEI purge is a key part of the “Stay Out of Spite” plan, according to University Officials.

Everyday life is a target too, says University President Adam Weinberg. “We’re of course going after everything that makes Denison unique or interesting, all the big stuff. But you’ll also notice a lot of little things, like how some showers simply don’t work, or don’t get hot. People have this misconception that it’s just because the plumbing is old, and hard to fix. It would actually cost a tiny fraction of Denison’s budget to get it working, but we’ve intentionally left it broken, so students can engage with the ‘Stay Out of Spite’ plan 24/7, even in the shower. That’s the Denison Difference.”

Some students have raised concerns that this new strategy is too big a change for the school, especially at a time where higher education in America is already in turmoil. But Weinberg assured us that this is not the case.

“Look, our core values are the same as they’ve always been. Denison is still a place where you can grab coffee with someone you disagree with. It’s just that now, the coffee costs 17 flex dollars and tastes like soap.”



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
