"We are... **Entry Level!**" This is a perfect name for a new band who is just getting started. It keeps expectations low, and lets you figure out your jam without too much pressure.


"We are... **Overdressed!**" A band with this name must dress in theme. A three-piece suit or evening gown should suffice, as long as you can still show off your moves.
