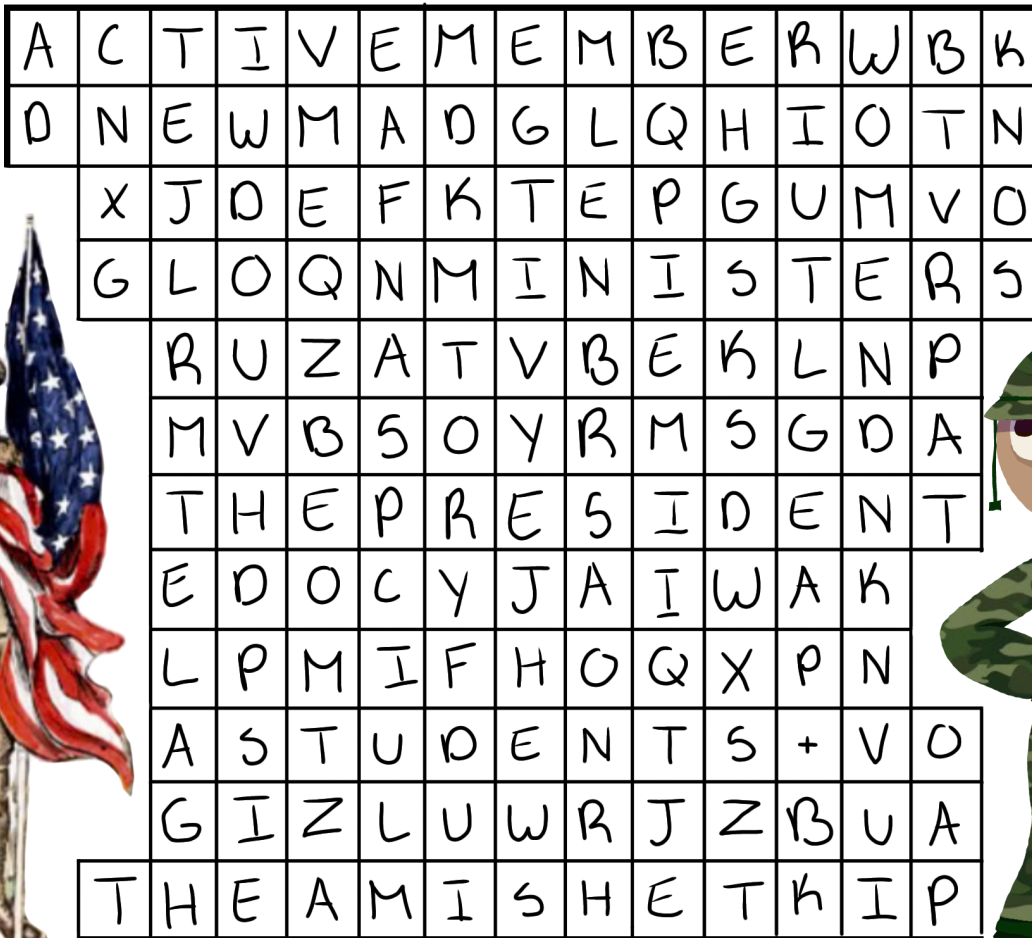
THE GREAT AMERICAN WORD SEARCH

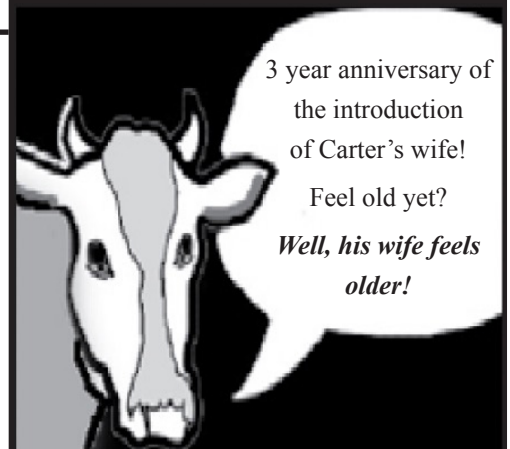
