

# What's In The Air?

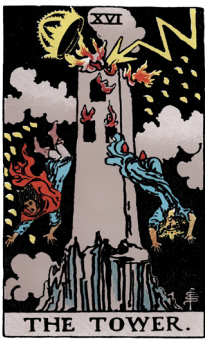
