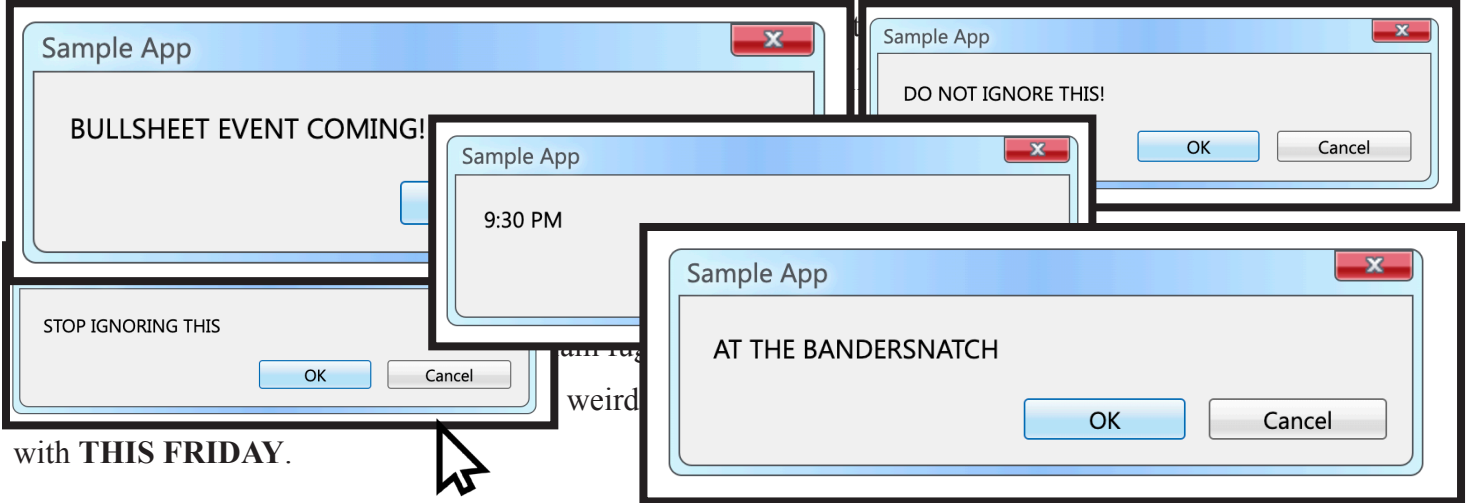

Meh, don't really care about what they got going on really.

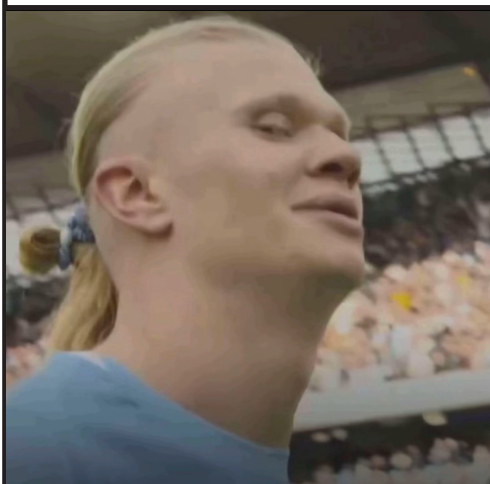
